

Port of Savannah

Total Annual Container Trade for Fiscal Years 2012 through 2016

Last updated: September 2016 (GPA Marketing)

Detail Summary:

- Savannah's total container trade decreased 1.6% in Fiscal Year 2016 (FY16) vs. FY15, when West Coast labor issues diverted a great deal of cargo to the port. Savannah retained an estimated 24% of the diverted cargo.
- FY16 trade ratio for Savannah: 51% Exports and 49% Imports
- Fueled by growth in imports (up 27%) and exports (up 16%), the Port of Savannah grew 21% from FY12 through FY16.
