### Total Annual Tonnage for Fiscal Years 2012 through 2016

Last updated: September 2016 (GPA Marketing)

#### Detail Summary:

- The Georgia Ports Authority marked record volumes in Fiscal Year 2016 (FY16) in freight moved by intermodal rail, the sixth consecutive year of record intermodal container volume.
- Total tonnage grew 16% from 26.6 million short tons in FY12 to 30.8 million short tons in FY16.
- Container tonnage comprised 83% of total tonnage during FY16.
