

CODE OF ETHICAL CONDUCT

The members of the Georgia Ports Authority, its staff and employees, in carrying out their mission to benefit Georgia's economy through international trade, will strive to comport themselves in accordance with the following Code of Ethical Conduct:

Comply with the spirit and the letter of all laws, rules, and regulations.

Act with and maintain a reputation for honesty and integrity and that their word is their bond. A promise made is a promise kept.

Avoid actual or apparent conflicts of interest.

Treat all fairly, with dignity and respect.

Promote work safety and protect the environment.

Act in good faith, responsibly and with due care, competence, and diligence.

Respect the confidentiality of information acquired in the course of work except when authorized or otherwise legally obligated to disclose such. Such information will not be used for personal advantage.

Maintain important and relevant skills, share knowledge, and provide accurate, complete, objective and relevant, timely and understandable information.

Achieve responsible use of and control over and protect the assets of the Authority.

Maintain and promote ethical business practices and values.

Conduct themselves to conform to the social convention or customs in effect at the place and time.
